Archbishop's
Annual Appeal

Thank you to all who have made their financial commitment to the Archbishop's Annual Appeal so far. Here is where each of our parishes is sitting in terms of their goal, as of Sunday December 30th.

Sacred Heart Parish of Boyd County has committed **\$12,795** to its financial goal of **\$12,527**, exceeding the goal by \$268.

St. Joseph – Amelia has committed **\$4630** to its financial goal of **\$3,219**, exceeding the goal by \$1411.

St. Joseph – Atkinson has committed **\$13,243** to its financial goal of **\$10,353**, exceeding its goal by \$2890.

St. Patrick - O'Neill has committed **\$41,242 (94.8%)** of its financial goal of **\$43,459**, leaving a balance of \$2217 to go.

St. Boniface – Stuart has committed **\$8355** of its financial goal of **\$7,890**, exceeding the goal by \$465.

Thank you to all of you who have made your financial commitment to the Archbishop's Annual Appeal so far. If you have not done so yet, please take a moment to do so. Special Collections

January 8 & 9: Seminary Collection

Gifts to the seminary fund enable the archdiocese to cover educational costs and pay stipends for living expenses for its seminary students in major & minor seminaries. A year's seminary education averages nearly \$40,000, and we currently have 19 seminarians in the archdiocese.

February 6 & 7: Home & Foreign Missions (4 in 1)

This collection supports 4 particular missional causes: aid to the church in Latin America, support the church in the Holy Land, providing funds for academic scholarships to attend the Catholic University of America (the only US university with pontifical faculties), and support for the 4 in 10 US dioceses considered mission territories.

Ask yourself this question — what would you pray for if you really believed God could and would do anything for you? In my experience, we all have something. We all have that miracle we're afraid to request, afraid we will be disappointed.

Do we doubt God's readiness to give because we ourselves have such an imperfect understanding of charity and love? Maybe if we had better faith in God, we would be more ready to give of ourselves — and maybe if we were more ready to give of ourselves, we would understand more clearly the ways of God.

Because we're not really afraid that God can't do something. We know He can do anything. What we're afraid of is that He will do what He always does: give us what we need, not what we want.

Have you ever had a friend in need and you just wanted to give them something — a meal, a phone call, a text? Not because you knew it would help, but simply because you wanted to reach out. And have they ever said to you: It wasn't so much what you gave, but the fact that you did. You gave them what they needed even if it wasn't what they specifically asked for.

When we give in this manner, we are giving as God does. Sometimes we are afraid to ask because we don't want to be disappointed. But remember, the blind man on the road got what he asked for, but he would have gotten what he needed even if his answer had been the opposite. God's generosity is always reckless, and it's always perfect.

Since 1974, National Catholic Schools Week is the annual celebration of Catholic education in the United States. It starts the last Sunday in January and runs all week, which in 2022 is January 30 – February 5. The theme for National Catholic Schools Week 2022 is “Catholic Schools: Faith. Excellence. Service.” Schools typically observe the annual celebration week with Masses, open houses and other activities for students, families, parishioners and community members. Through these events, schools focus on the value Catholic education provides to young people and its contributions to our church, our communities and our nation.

The St. Mary's Catholic Identity committee has been busy planning for this year's celebration. As part of CSW, we are blessed to have Danny Leger, former St. Mary's Theology teacher/Youth Coordinator come for a mini-retreat for our students. In return for his time, we are offering all of our school Mass collections for the mission he helped found: Hope of the Poor. This mission works with the poor in Mexico. Their mission field is drug-addicted street kids, homeless families, and people who live at the city dump.
